



MEN'S CLUB MEETINGS

Men's club meets the 1st Monday of the month. 6:00pm in Winter & 7:00pm in Summer

Holy Week—from Palm Sunday to Easter Sunday—is the most sacred time in the Church, even more profound than Christmas!

Holy Week recalls the final days of Jesus' life and invites us into deeper reflection, sacrifice, and renewal.

We begin with Palm Sunday, remembering Jesus' entry into Jerusalem and receiving blessed palms as we reflect on His Passion.

The Chrism Mass, held early in the week, is when sacred oils are blessed and priests renew their vows.


Holy Thursday marks the start of the Easter Triduum. At the Mass of the Lord's Supper, we remember the Eucharist and witness the washing of feet—a sign of Christ's call to serve.

On Good Friday, we honor Jesus' crucifixion. In silence, prayer, and the Stations of the Cross, we reflect on His sacrifice and the gift of redemption.

Holy Saturday is a quiet day of waiting. That evening, the Easter Vigil celebrates the Resurrection in a powerful liturgy full of light and joy, often welcoming new members into the Church.

Easter Sunday proclaims Jesus' victory over death—the heart of our faith. The Easter season begins, inviting us to live with renewed hope and joy in Christ's Resurrection
